Dave LeGrow has devoted more than twenty years to the soccer community as a volunteer with the local and provincial associations. His involvement covers a wide range, from referee, coach and convenor, through to treasurer, secretary, and organizing committee functions.

Dave began volunteering with Mount Pearl Soccer (MPSA) in 1994 when he obtained his Class 3 certificate and began refereeing. At about the same time he took on the role of Tournament Convenor, and while maintaining those responsibilities, he also “signed on” as a House League Coordinator and coach, responding to the needs of the association. He served as Tournament Convenor and referee for more than 15 years. During much of this period he also served as a member of the Finance and Management Committees, the ‘Member Senior & All Star’ Committee, Management Committee for

Mount Pearl’s Challenge Cup team, and MPSA representative at Provincial soccer meetings (NLSA).

During his tenure with the MPSA Executive, Dave was part of the task group charged with completion of three major capital developments – Field Lighting, a new Clubhouse, and Field Turf. In 2012 he also served as Secretary to the MPSA 40th Anniversary Committee. In addition to local Executive responsibilities, Dave has served more than 15 years with the NLSA Board and Executive, including as Treasurer and Secretary.

Dave has been recognized as ‘Executive of the Year’ by the MPSA, the Sport Alliance and the NLSA. He was inducted to the MPSA Hall of Fame and the NLSA Hall of Fame in 2012.
