

Mount Pearl Sports Hall of Fame Inductee Raeleen (Dunne) Baggs Athlete 2009



Raeleen (Dunne) Baggs has been recognized for her excellence as an athlete on a multitude of levels. Raeleen has participated as a player at the Minor level, the Provincial level and the University level, all of which demonstrate her enduring commitment to sports. One of Raeleen's achievements, as there are many, include the Newfoundland and Labrador Soccer receiving Association's regular season MVP award that has now been titled the Raeleen (Dunne) Baggs Award. Raeleen has demonstrated the highest level of dedication throughout her 23 years as a member of Team Newfoundland for soccer. Moreover, Raeleen has expressed a similar amount of dedication to sports through her 13 years of participation in the Jubilee Cup Competition with teams from Mount Pearl. During the 1990's, Raeleen was named Female Player of the Decade by the NLSA. She was a member of nine Provincial NLSA Championship Teams (seven as a minor) as well as a member of two Jubilee Cup teams.

Raeleen has encountered an enormous amount of success in her soccer career. A highlight from her career would be the seven consecutive year wins she was part of as a member of a Mount Pearl team representing Newfoundland and Labrador at National Tournaments in 1987- 1993. Furthermore, Raeleen was once named the Newfoundland and Labrador soccer senior player of the year. In addition to her soccer career, Raeleen was also part of the squash community. As a member of the Newfoundland and Labrador Women's Squash team, Raeleen attended the Canada Games. Raeleen's accomplishments are recognized at the highest of regard and continue to be an inspiration for athletes everywhere.
